Postdoctoral Fellowship in Academic Libraries for 2014

The Council on Library and Information Resources (CLIR) is pleased to announce the Postdoctoral Fellowship in Academic Libraries for humanists, social scientists, and scientists.

This fellowship provides recent Ph.D. recipients in any discipline a unique opportunity to develop expertise in the new forms of scholarly research and the information resources that support them, both traditional and digital, that are challenging research institutions. The program offers fellowships to individuals who believe that there are opportunities to develop meaningful linkages among disciplinary scholarship, libraries, archives, and evolving digital tools. Former fellows have high placement rates as researchers and professionals in academic libraries and as members of teaching faculties.

Fellowships begin in summer 2014 and range from one to two years in length. The fellowships pay a salary plus benefits at one of the collaborat-

ing academic libraries that serve as fellowship sponsors. Sponsors range from large research universities to small liberal arts colleges across the United States and Canada.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have earned their Ph.D.s within the past five years or earn them before starting the program.
- Fellows must be in residence at a sponsoring institution for the duration of the fellowship, and must be able to attend a mandatory seminar at Bryn Mawr in July/August 2014.

Deadline

Applications must be submitted by December 27, 2013.
